



COVID-19 and Rider Safety Precautions

Pedal for a Purpose is committed to a duty of care to deliver a safe and enjoyable ride for cyclists and volunteers. The measures below have been implemented for the health and safety of all participants.

Measures to help reduce the spread of COVID-19

- Stay home if you have tested positive or if you have had close contact with someone in the last 14 days who displays symptoms
- Wash hands frequently and/or use hand sanitizer
- Cover mouth and nose when sneezing and coughing
- Wear face coverings (Not required while riding)
- Maintain social distancing of 6 Feet

Ride Day – April 10

- Keep 6' distance at check in
- Maintain distance and do not congregate at the ride start
- Masks are required at rest stops when refueling nutrition
- Riders must use hand sanitizer before proceeding into the rest stop area
- Masks are not required outside the tent area at the rest stops for consumption
- All rest stop nutrition will be prepackaged for safe distribution
- All rest stop volunteers will wear gloves and masks
- SAG drivers will wear masks and all passengers will be required to wear a mask during transport

Route Safety

- All riders must obey all state and local traffic laws
- All riders must obey all Law Enforcement Personnel, Ride Officials and Volunteers
- All riders must practice appropriate cycling and safety etiquette at all times during the event
- All riders must wear a bicycle helmet
- Headphones, cell phones, ear buds, radios and similar audio devices used in, on or around the rider's head or ears are not permitted while riding (Tandem communication accessories are allowed)
